## Reasons why discus sexuality

- how we feel about our sexuality, effects how we care for ourselves - it is therefore a health issue. Also political
- issues on sexuality are involved in gynecological, birth control, abortion. If counselling, need to be comfortable.
- ease we feel about our own sexuality will reflect directly on ease with which we speak with others.
- this does not mean we have to have every aspect of sexualiy worked out personally - we need to be comfortable
- no pressure on any member to talk with a women on any subject that is not comfortable.
- as part of self determination, we support all women to have free and responsible expression of their sexuality and the way in which they want to express it. ( lesbian celebate, bisexual, heterosexual, + )
- make no assumptions - sexually active by self or with others, heterosexual etc
- an aim of the H.C. is to help women experience their sexuality as a source of pride, strength and joy.
