

DES (diethylstilbestrol) is a synthetic estrogen which was frequently given to pregnant women between 1941 and 1971, mostly to prevent miscarriage. It has been linked to health problems in the children of the women given the drug, including fertility and pregnancy problems, and, rarely, vaginal cancer. In this workshop we will provide up-to-date information on DES and discuss ways for DES-exposed women to get emotional support and adequate medical care.
