<u>The CENTRE</u> (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgendered and thier Allies) - Sadie very willing to help and provided a lot of contact suggestions.

<u>Brittania Volunteer Centre</u> - Met with the volunteer coordinator and she was EXTREMELY helpful in suggesting women who would be good advocates and may have the time to commit

Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives - Researched info on Health Policy in BC
