<u>SAFE FIXING SITES</u> would mean a dramatic reduction in the number of used needles and wrappers on the streets. Users would be monitored by trained peers and personnel to all but eliminate overdose deaths. They would have access to information, education and referrals as well as clean equipment which would contain and reduce the many devastating diseases that are presently such a burden on our health care. They would have access to support systems not available on the streets if they wish to try and fight or control their addictions.
