Lawyers for the Woodward's Squat advise people who were arrested yesterday to write down in as much detail as possible what happened, right away: during the arrest, in the cells, and at the courthouse. They also suggest writing about the following questions:

1. When did you go into the squat?
2. How many nights did you stay?
3. Did the police read you the injunction?
4. Did you read the written injunction?
5. Did the police use force during the arrest?
6. Did the police read you your rights?
7. Did the police permit you to call a lawyer?

The Friends of the Woodward's Squat can provide pens & paper to write things down or an audio recorder for people who prefer to provide oral testimony.
