
Re: City of Vancouver v. Claude Maurice et al

I have not yet received a complete disclosure package from the City of Vancouver. This is my second request to the City for the issuance of a complete package. My first request is attached.

Please deliver to me in person at the Woodward's Squat as soon as possible a complete package which includes all documents from the original package mentioned missing in my letter of 08 November 2002. These include:

- (1) a copy of the affidavit sworn by City of Vancouver Streets Administration Engineer Tom Hammel on 04 November 2002;
- (2) a *true* copy of Exhibit "A" from the affidavit sworn by City of Vancouver Communications Department Multimedia & Even Manager Thomas Donovan on 05 November 2002. My disclosure package failed to include a true copy and in fact included but a black and white photocopied reproduction of the plastic videocassette *casing*. The true copy must be presented to me in a format that I may view, as stated in my first request to the City.
- (3) a *true* copy of each of Exhibits "F" through "Y" from the affidavit sworn by City of Vancouver Surveyor Michael G. Thomson on 30 October 2002. As I stated in my previous request, the reproductions of these Exhibits are of such a poor quality that it has been impossible for me to distinguish the structures, objects, substances or things which are purported to be at issue in the alleged By-law infraction. As stated in my previous unanswered request to the City, the true copies of these Exhibits must be reproduced with a reasonable amount of quality and in an accessible format so that I may view them prior to my appearance as a Defendant in the Supreme Court of British Columbia on 19-20 November 2002.
